		<ul> <li>Para 4 – <u>labour relations matters;</u></li> </ul>	
		Para 5 – <u>legal professional privilege;</u>	
		<ul> <li>Para 6 – <u>a notice</u>, order or direction;</li> </ul>	
		<ul> <li>Para 7 – the prevention, investigation or</li> </ul>	
		prosecution of crime;
