		"That, under S.100 (A) (4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the public be excluded from the meeting for the following matter(s) on the grounds that it/they involve(s) the likely disclosure of exempt information as defined in the relevant paragraphs (to be specified) of Part 1 of Schedule 12 (A) of the said Act".
		These paragraphs are as follows:

		• Para 2 – the identity of any individual:
		• Para 3 – <u>financial or business affairs;</u>
		• Para 4 – <u>labour relations matters;</u>
		Para 5 – <u>legal professional privilege;</u>
		• Para 6 – <u>a notice, order or direction;</u>
		• Para 7 – the prevention, investigation or
		prosecution of crime;
		and may need to be considered as 'exempt'.
