| Background to the issue                                           | On Monday 18th January Councillor A Clayton informed the Taxi<br>Licensing Forum of the experiences of a disabled woman from<br>Matchborough who went shopping and became stranded at the<br>shops as she hadn't given any taxi firm 48 hours' notice (Redditch<br>Standard, 22/1/16, p3). Disability Action Redditch (DAR) also<br>report that disabled people have been charged 3 times more than<br>a non-disabled person for the same journey and that several taxi<br>firms refuse to take bookings for passengers who are wheelchair<br>users. Although charging more for a disabled person is<br>discriminatory it is common practise according to Scope and<br>DAR.<br>In 2013 an Overview and Scrutiny Task Group on "Access for<br>disabled people" recommended that the age of wheelchair<br>accessible vehicles (WAV) should be increased to elevate this<br>problem. However according to Worcestershire Regulatory<br>Services (WRS) this has not led to a significant increase in WAV<br>which, with a rising population with physical disabilities, is only<br>compounding the problem.
