		These paragraphs are as follows:	
		Subject to the "public interest" test, information relating to:	
		<ul> <li>Para 1 – <u>any individual;</u></li> </ul>	
		• Para 2 – the identity of any individual;	
		• Para 3 – financial or business affairs;	
		• Para 4 – <u>labour relations matters;</u>	
		Para 5 – <u>legal professional privilege;</u>	
		• Para 6 – <u>a notice, order or direction;</u>	
		Para 7 – the prevention, investigation or	
		prosecution of crime;	
		and may need to be considered as 'exempt'.
