These paragraphs are as follows:

Subject to the "public interest" test, information relating to:

- Para 1 any individual;
- Para 2 the identity of any individual;
- Para 3 financial or business affairs;
- Para 4 labour relations matters;
- Para 5 legal professional privilege;
- Para 6 a notice, order or direction;
- Para 7 the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime;

and may need to be considered as 'exempt'.
