## STREET TRADING CONSULTATION

Redditch Borough Council is currently reviewing the way in which it controls street trading in the Council's administrative area.

As part of this process, the Council wishes to consult relevant stakeholders and the wider public in relation to two particular areas:

- The current designation of streets as prohibited or consent streets
- A revised draft street trading policy

This consultation questionnaire is therefore in two parts.

Part A deals with the consultation on the designation of streets for the purpose of controlling street trading. Part B deals with the consultation on the revised draft street trading policy.

#### Part A – Consultation on the Designation of Streets for the purpose of controlling street trading

#### **Background**

Under schedule 4 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982, Councils can control street trading by designating streets in their area as one of the following:

Consent streets	A street in which street trading is prohibited without the consent of the Council.
Licence streets	A street in which street trading is prohibited without a licence granted by the Council.
Prohibited streets	A street in which street trading is prohibited.

#### **Current Position**

Currently, Redditch Borough Council has designated the following streets in its area as <u>prohibited streets</u>:

All other streets in the Council's area have been designated as consent streets.

#### **Proposal Under Consideration**

The Council is considering the merits of re-designated **all** the streets in its area as consent streets and therefore no longer designating any streets as prohibited streets.

This would allow applications for street trading consents to be considered in relation to any street and the application would then be consulted upon and considered on its own merits in line with the Council's street trading policy.

Before deciding whether to take this approach, the Council would like to consult relevant stakeholders and the wider public on the proposal.
